OVERVIEW

GFM is seeking a strategic and detail-oriented Vision Trip Planning Supervisor to oversee the development and execution of all vision trips. This role is responsible for ensuring that each trip is meticulously planned and an encouragement to what ministry might look like for the potential missionary. The Supervisor will manage all logistical aspects, from itinerary creation to on-the-ground support, while also fostering a safe, purposeful, and transformative experience for every participant. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and manage detailed trip itineraries, including scheduling a diversity of ministry site visits, missionary meetings, and pastoral interviews.
- Create and refine standard operating procedures and planning templates for all aspects of trip planning, ensuring consistency and best practices.
- Manage trip budgets, monitor expenses, and provide regular financial updates to ensure fiscal responsibility and effective use of resources.
- Maintain clear and effective communication with all ministry partners.
- Cultivate and expand our network of ministry partnerships with key community leaders, pastors, churches, ministries and organizations.
- Prepare detailed post-trip reports for leadership, summarizing key outcomes, challenges, and insights.
