OVERVIEW

Seeking a detail-oriented Vision Trip Intake Supervisor to manage the entire participant intake process. This role oversees applications, conducts screening calls, and handles all administrative logistics, from payments to pre-trip communication. The goal is to provide a caring, seamless, and organized experience, ensuring participants are well-prepared for a successful and meaningful trip. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand but working fully remote is also an option.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Manage the full participant intake cycle for all Vision Trips, from initial inquiry through pre-trip preparation.
- Serve as the primary point of contact for all applicant and participant questions, providing timely and professional communication.
- Conduct the applicant qualification process, reviewing applications, scheduling and conducting video interviews, and evaluating candidate suitability.
- Manage all participant logistics including: tracking payments, providing pre-trip materials, providing any additional pertinent information and or resources.
- Maintain accurate and organized records of all applicants' information, communications, and financial status using a designated system.
- Provide regular status reports on the intake and payment process to relevant leadership and trip coordinators.

- Must identify as a maturing believer in Jesus Christ with a high view of Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17;

- Must be ready to experience significant missions training and discipleship through GFM's Missionary Training School (in person sessions or online)
