# **JOB DESCRIPTION for Evangelist**



## **OVERVIEW**

The Evangelist is the field-level executor responsible for ensuring abundant Gospel sowing by directly engaging the lost in the target area through diverse methods of outreach. This role requires actively planning and conducting various evangelistic activities, ranging from intentional one-on-one sharing to organizing and participating in mini and large Gospel crusades. The Evangelist is also accountable for diligently recording conversion decisions and follow-up data to facilitate a smooth handoff to the next stage of the multiplication pipeline. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Gospel Sowing Activities: Personally plan, organize, and execute a consistent schedule of
  one-on-one and group evangelism activities, effectively utilizing both oral and media-based methods
  to clearly present the Gospel of Christ to the lost.
- Mass Evangelism Participation: Actively plan and participate in larger outreach efforts, including
  organizing and presenting at mini and large Gospel crusades, often working with and platforming
  other evangelists.
- Conversion Record Keeping: Maintain meticulous, accurate, and up-to-date records of all spiritual contacts and decisions, categorizing them using the established "green, yellow, red" system.
- Data Handoff and Reporting: Ensure timely and systematic transfer of all spiritual decision data and contact information to the Evangelism Coordinator to facilitate immediate follow-up by the Church Planters.
- Outreach Resource Management: Secure, manage, and deploy necessary evangelism materials
  and media for daily outreach activities, ensuring appropriate and contextual use within the target
  community.
- **Spiritual and Skill Development:** Continuously seek to improve personal evangelistic effectiveness by participating in team training, seeking coaching, and maintaining a healthy personal spiritual life.

## REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must personally embrace <u>GFM's purpose</u>, vision, <u>values</u>. and <u>statement of faith</u>
- Must identify as a maturing believer in Jesus Christ with a high view of Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17;
   Col 3:16-17)
- Must demonstrate humility, teachability, and an ability to work well with others (Eph 4:15)
- Must display advanced interpersonal relational skills and be dedicated to peacemaking (Heb 10:24-25)
- Must function well both independently and in a team environment (1 Cor 12:25-26)
- Must be able use or learn internal communications and technology systems (Email, Google Drive, Slack, Salesforce, etc.)
- Must be ready to experience significant missions training and discipleship through GFM's Missionary Training School (in person sessions or online)

## RECOMMENDED

 A College Degree is preferred but not required; informal training/experience in administration, communications, team building, human resource management, organization, leadership, and/or ministry will be considered
