JOB DESCRIPTION for Church Planting Movement Coordinator



OVERVIEW

The Church Planting Movement (CPM) Coordinator is a strategic leadership role responsible for the oversight and health of multiple Church Planting Streams, ensuring a sustained movement of multiplication. This position directly coaches and mentors Church Planters to establish healthy, self-reproducing churches where disciples make disciples. The Coordinator's core focus is to identify and resolve systemic issues that impede exponential growth, driving the overall ministry toward becoming a fully realized church planting movement. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Church Planter Coaching and Mentorship: Provide direct, ongoing coaching and mentorship to a
 portfolio of Church Planters, specifically focused on equipping them to make disciples who multiply,
 leading to self-sustaining churches.
- Stream Health and Multiplication Oversight: Actively oversee and monitor the health of multiple church planting streams, establishing metrics and accountability to ensure established disciple-making groups successfully transition into healthy, reproducing churches.
- **Movement Blockage Removal:** Proactively identify theological, cultural, or systemic blockages preventing the acceleration of a Church Planting Movement (CPM) and facilitate strategic means to remove these obstacles in collaboration with local planters.
- Leadership Development and Training: Organize and implement standardized leadership training
 and development programs across all planting streams to ensure a continuous pipeline of equipped
 indigenous church leaders.
- Integration with Training Programs: Serve as a key connection point to ensure Missionary Training School (MTS) students and apprentices receive practical, hands-on experience by integrating them into active church planting teams.
- Strategy and Best Practice Facilitation: Regularly gather Church Planters for strategic planning, celebration, and fellowship, facilitating the sharing of best practices and ensuring alignment with proven CPM principles.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must personally embrace <u>GFM's purpose</u>, vision, <u>values</u>. and <u>statement of faith</u>
- Must identify as a maturing believer in Jesus Christ with a high view of Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17;
 Col 3:16-17)
- Must demonstrate humility, teachability, and an ability to work well with others (Eph 4:15)
- Must display advanced interpersonal relational skills and be dedicated to peacemaking (Heb 10:24-25)
- Must function well both independently and in a team environment (1 Cor 12:25-26)
- Must be able use or learn internal communications and technology systems (Email, Google Drive, Slack, Salesforce, etc.)
- Must be ready to experience significant missions training and discipleship through GFM's Missionary Training School (in person sessions or online)

RECOMMENDED

 A College Degree is preferred but not required; informal training/experience in administration, communications, team building, human resource management, organization, leadership, and/or ministry will be considered
