JOB DESCRIPTION for Burmese MTS Supervisor



OVERVIEW

The Burmese MTS Supervisor is responsible for the direct day-to-day management and high-quality delivery of the Missionary Training School curriculum specifically for the Burmese-speaking track. This involves recruiting, scheduling, and supporting all Burmese-language instructors and ensuring the curriculum is culturally relevant and effectively preparing students for long-term missionary service. They serve as the primary on-site mentor and shepherd for the Burmese-speaking students, focusing on their spiritual growth and successful preparation for the mission field. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Burmese Track Program Management: Oversee the day-to-day operations and schedule for the Burmese MTS track, ensuring all classes and special events are executed efficiently and meet established quality standards.
- **Instructor Recruitment and Support:** Recruit, schedule, and provide ongoing support and resources for all Burmese-speaking trainers, teachers, and guest lecturers, ensuring consistency in curriculum delivery and cross-cultural application.
- **Student Mentorship and Discipleship:** Serve as the primary mentor, spiritual shepherd, and pastoral care resource for all students enrolled in the Burmese track, guiding their vocational clarity and personal growth toward long-term service.
- Curriculum Implementation: Directly manage the implementation of the contextualized Burmese MTS curriculum, providing real-time feedback to the MTS Coordinator on the effectiveness and relevance of the modules.
- Logistical Support and Resource Allocation: Coordinate classroom needs, material distribution, technology setup, and any necessary logistical support for the Burmese track, working within the budget approved by the MTS Coordinator.
- **Recruitment and Onboarding Support:** Assist the MTS Coordinator with the recruitment, application processing, and initial onboarding of new Burmese-speaking students, ensuring a smooth transition into the Bangkok school environment.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must personally embrace <u>GFM's purpose</u>, vision, <u>values</u>. and <u>statement of faith</u>
- Must identify as a maturing believer in Jesus Christ with a high view of Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17;
 Col 3:16-17)
- Must demonstrate humility, teachability, and an ability to work well with others (Eph 4:15)
- Must display advanced interpersonal relational skills and be dedicated to peacemaking (Heb 10:24-25)
- Must function well both independently and in a team environment (1 Cor 12:25-26)
- Must be able use or learn internal communications and technology systems (Email, Google Drive, Slack, Salesforce, etc.)
- Must be ready to experience significant missions training and discipleship through GFM's Missionary Training School (in person sessions or online)

RECOMMENDED

 A College Degree is preferred but not required; informal training/experience in administration, communications, team building, human resource management, organization, leadership, and/or ministry will be considered
