JOB DESCRIPTION for E.S.L. Team Member



OVERVIEW

The ESL Team Member is the primary classroom instructor responsible for delivering high-quality, engaging English language education to students in a professional and culturally sensitive manner. This role focuses on intentionally cultivating relationships with students, utilizing the classroom environment and curriculum as a natural platform for gentle spiritual inquiry and Gospel sharing. The Team Member is crucial for identifying receptive students and diligently reporting contacts to the ESL Coordinator, ensuring a smooth handoff to the multiplication pipeline. It is full time and support raising or self-funding is required. The role is based out of Bangkok, Thailand.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- High-Quality Instruction and Professionalism: Deliver engaging, effective English lessons in a
 professional manner, following the established curriculum and maintaining a high standard of
 classroom management and educational integrity.
- Intentional Relational Outreach: Actively and ethically build deep, trusting relationships with students, leveraging the classroom and post-class interactions to create natural opportunities for spiritual conversations and modeling Christ-like character.
- **Gospel Sowing and Spiritual Inquiry:** Utilize the curriculum and context to facilitate gentle Gospel sharing, address student spiritual questions, and introduce foundational truths, ensuring students are aware of the ministry's core mission.
- Student Identification and Reporting: Diligently identify and track students who show spiritual interest (seekers, new believers, or those asking questions), promptly reporting these warm contacts and their specific needs to the ESL Coordinator.
- **Pipeline Coordination and Handoff:** Work with the Coordinator to facilitate the smooth and timely transition of contacts to the Evangelism Team for initial follow-up and the Church Planters for discipleship and group formation.
- Classroom Administration and Logistics: Manage daily classroom logistics, maintain accurate student attendance and progress records, and ensure the proper use and care of all teaching materials and ministry resources.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must personally embrace <u>GFM's purpose</u>, vision, <u>values</u>. and <u>statement of faith</u>
- Must identify as a maturing believer in Jesus Christ with a high view of Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17;
 Col 3:16-17)
- Must demonstrate humility, teachability, and an ability to work well with others (Eph 4:15)
- Must display advanced interpersonal relational skills and be dedicated to peacemaking (Heb 10:24-25)
- Must function well both independently and in a team environment (1 Cor 12:25-26)
- Must be able use or learn internal communications and technology systems (Email, Google Drive, Slack, Salesforce, etc.)
- Must be ready to experience significant missions training and discipleship through GFM's Missionary Training School (in person sessions or online)

RECOMMENDED

 A College Degree is preferred but not required; informal training/experience in administration, communications, team building, human resource management, organization, leadership, and/or ministry will be considered
